

A-Tech: *IH Storm Water Services*

The Industrial General Permit regulates industrial storm water discharges and authorized non-storm water discharges from industrial facilities in California. Organizations that are **REQUIRED** to file for discharge permits include:

- Manufacturing Facilities
- Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage, of Disposal Facilities
- Landfills, Land Application Sites, and Open Dumps
- Recycling Facilities
- Steam Electric Power Generating Facilities
- Transportation Facilities
- Sewage & Wastewater Treatment

Required services A-Tech provides for the above industries:

- *Assist Entities* submit a No Exposure Certification (NEC) demonstrating that their facilities have no exposure of industrial activities and materials to storm water discharges *No Exposure Certification (NEC) (QISP or SM-QISP required)*
- *Assist entities who are claiming "No Discharge through the Notice of non-applicability (NONA) (QISP or SM-QISP required)*
- Assist New Dischargers determine coverage eligibility for Discharges to an impaired water body *(QISP or SM-QISP required)*
 - *Notice of Intent (NOI)*
 - Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) Development
 - *Sampling Collection, SWPPP Requirements*
 - *Reporting Requirements Level I & Level II Exceedance Response Actions (ERA) & Site Assessments*
